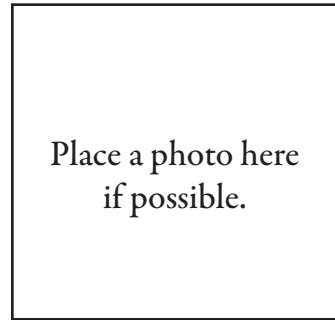

Complete a form for each of your pets. Make sure the forms are for animals that are currently in the home. When an Animal Control Officer spends time looking for pets that are not there, it reduces the time they can use to save other pets.

You could place them in a "zip" bag and tape to your door, or attach a small mail box to an outside wall. When you call Animal Control to go to your home, tell them where they can find the information.
